### **Refugee Resettlement Initiative**

#### Oct. 2021: Afghan Action Plan

22 institutions of higher ed. across 12 states have supported Afghans

#### Dec. 2021: Refugee Resettlement Initiative

Expanded for all people with forcibly displaced backgrounds (e.g., refugee status, asylum seekers)

Raising awareness of a new role systems can play as co-sponsors and private sponsors of refugees Providing technical & coordination support to states & champions through communities of practice

Advocating & raising funds from the federal, state, and philanthropic sectors






